Weddings at the Paicines Ranch


We average between 15 and 20 weddings per year and we are trying to encourage eco-friendly weddings.

























Eco Weddings

Workshops & Retreats


We host our own events (Learning Journey, Women in Ranching, Lead with Land) and we also let others use our space for their own gatherings.




